

Village of Corfu Regular Minutes January 10, 2024

The Village of Corfu held its Regular Meeting January 10, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at located at 116 East Main St, Corfu NY 14036.

In attendance: Mayor Sargent, Deputy Mayor Doktor, Trustee Krzemien, Trustee Lauer, Trustee Reisdorf. Also in attendance: Clerk, Jennifer Eck, Maintenance, Loren Vinent, Code Enforcement, Robin Johnson, Planning Board Chairman, Mark Zimmerman, Camden Representative, Brian Schollard.

Residents in attendance: Linda Sformo, Ken Brauner, Matt Orleman, Pam Ware, Ron Long and Erika & Rafael Lopez.

Pam Ware addressed the Board to explain the Daughters of the Revolution will be celebrating the anniversary of the Vietnam Era and are looking for recipients of this Era to publicly acknowledge their devotion to our Country. Pam will send information for a post on the newsletter and Deputy Mayor Doktor will post on the Corfu Village Advisor.

Planning and Code Enforcement:

- Application for Outpour Ministries for 47 Main Street; permit is being reviewed from planning board to finalize. There is questions pertaining to the driveway with the State DOT.
- Planning Board will be meeting on the 4th Tuesday of the month; however, Mr. Zimmerman will reach out to the Genesee County Planning Board to see if a site plan review will be required.
- Deputy Mayor Doktor will reach out to the State DOT to inquire about new contact information.
- Discuss what the organization will be doing; local hub for food pantries and will be open one day a week for the public to worship and collect food.
- Mr. Johnson stated he will issue a temporary permit for 3 months; during that time the organization must fulfill all requirements from the planning board.
- Grand opening celebration will be held January 19th @ 6pm

Police Update:

- Received \$878.30 from the STOP DWI grant funding
- Waiting for other grant money to be received.
- NYS will be auditing the police department files.
- Car #1 had an exhaust leak and 2 recalls; currently being repaired.
- Car #4 radio and radar has been installed.
- Officer Reeves is currently training to become a breathalyzer instructor.

• Corfu Police Department has been invited to become part of the Genesee County Law Enforcement Council.

Court Update:

- Received \$24,291.00 for December 2023 Fines
- Court has had issues with their credit card machine and have requested new machine provided by the Unified Court System.

Maintenance Update:

- Mr. Vinent
 - Mailbox has been put up for the fuel logs; the other box wasn't weather resistant.
 - Mr. Waff is working on inventory for the State report.
 - On a waiting list with Reisdorf to get a 500-gallon tank for unleaded fuel; currently using 125 gallons a week.
 - Discussed the quotes for the camera system at the plant; certain cameras are to be used if anticipation of a homeland security grant.
 - Currently getting a quote for blacktop sealing for the budget.
 - Mayor Sargent thanked Mr. Vincent for coming in due to the recent windstorm and to deal with branches down and clean up.

3 CORFU #2:

MRB will be asked to investigate the value of TVSS on electrical panels. Status? A visual alarm light needs to be installed on the outside of the Influent Room to indicate high levels of hazardous gases being present. Status?

- 4 Large Maintenance Building: All flag poles have been returned to Maintenance to be stored for the winter. A mass effort is being made to sort and identify all of the miscellaneous parts and hardware that has been lying around the maintenance shop for years. All obsolete and non-repairable items will be discarded
- <u>5</u> MAINTENANCE GARAGE:. The motion detectors in both the Maintenance Garage and the Maintenance Shop have been relocated to eliminate false activation of the area lighting when the

buildings are unoccupied. This will continue to be monitored until a satisfactory result is achieved. Inventory and organization is underway.

6 GENERAL: 1. Can the Board officially name all of the buildings at the WWTP's to avoid any confusion when people reference them? Refer to attached suggestions. ?

2. FUEL FARM: A mail box has been installed in place of the "realtor's box which filled up with snow.

THE FUEL TOTALIZING LOG. Loren Vincent will be responsible for reordering bulk tank Levels and ordering emergency refills. The tanks are now being topped off every 3 weeks.

Fuel usage patterns are being evaluated.

RESOLUTION #1 - 2024 - SCHEDULING POLLING PLACE, HOURS OF ELECTION, AND NO REGISTRATION DAY.

WHEREAS ELECTION LAW Section 15-104(3) and 15-118(3), requires the Board of Trustees of a Village to adopt a resolution at least sixty (60) days prior to a Village Election specifying:

- 1. The polling place in each election district, and
- 2. The hours, during which polls shall be open, which shall include at least the hours from noon to nine o'clock in the evening.
- 3. There will be no Registration Day for the Village of Corfu.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Village Election will be held from Noon to 9 o'clock p.m. at the Corfu Village Hall, 116 East Main Street, Tuesday, March 19, 2024. There will be no Registration Day in the Village of Corfu.

Sewer WWTP update:

- Main lift station both pumps failed; needed to take pump to Bailey's.
- MRB is working on a solution for plant #2 due to the design of the pretreatment.
- Mayor Sargent discussed the MRB evaluation.
 - Having a conversation with Town of Pembroke to resolve the design issues, agreeing that MRB is the engineer going forward on all projects.
 - o MRB is looking in to other repairs needed to combine with Darien project.
 - Some issues should be tied into the grant.

- Mr. Schollard said there is a need for smoke testing this year; will get a quote to the Village.
- Mr. Schollard said Depot lift station went down completely; found a towel in the pumps.
- UV project concrete is poured for Sono tubes, electrical panels are here, pole barn is next step.
- Lawley insurance came out to review insurance policies; even though Pembroke's buildings are stated on the policy, the Village is not paying for the insurance on those buildings.
- Received reimbursement from Yancey's Fancy for the purchase of the two air mixers, \$6,926.00.
- Sewer billing- Keith & Sue Busch sent a letter asking the board to approve a sewer credit as water usage increased during the concrete mixing for the new build at 16 Depot St.

Trustee Reisdorf made a motion to credit Keith Bush a \$45.25 credit on the sewer billing; Trustee Krzemien 2nd.
