Planning & Code Enforcement Update:

- Mr. Johnson sent letter to resident on Long's Lane regarding unlicensed vehicles and dog waste.

**BOND RESOLUTION
(SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM)**

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Corfu, Genesee County, New York, held at 116 E. Main St, in Corfu, New York, in said Village, on the 11th day of January, 2023, at 6:30 o'clock P.M., Prevailing Time.

The following resolution was offered by Trustee Kenneth Lauer, who moved its adoption, seconded by Trustee Michael Doktor, to-wit:

BOND RESOLUTION DATED JANUARY 11, 2023.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN AND FOR THE VILLAGE OF CORFU, GENESEE COUNTY, NEW YORK, AT A NEW MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST OF \$1,498,750 AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$541,750 SERIAL BONDS OF SAID VILLAGE TO PAY COSTS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, all requirements for purposes of the State Environmental Quality Review Act have been satisfied with respect to the project described below; NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Corfu, Genesee County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The construction of disinfection system improvements to the wastewater treatment plant in and for the Village of Corfu, Genesee County, New York, including incidental improvements and costs, is hereby authorized, **SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**, at a new maximum estimated cost of \$1,498,750.

Section 2. The plan for the financing of the aforesaid maximum estimated cost is (i) by the issuance of \$957,000 serial bonds of said Village authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to a bond resolution dated August 14, 2019, and (ii) by the issuance of the \$541,750 serial bonds hereby authorized pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law; provided, however, the amount of bonds to be issued shall be reduced by the amount of grants received for such project.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes is forty years, pursuant to subdivision 4 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law. It is hereby further determined that the maximum maturity of the serial bonds herein authorized will exceed five years.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said Village of Corfu, Genesee County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. To the extent not paid from other sources, there shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said Village, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Village Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Village Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the serial bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue serial bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the Village Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of such Village. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Village Treasurer shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 7. The Village Treasurer is hereby further authorized, at his/her sole discretion, to execute a project finance and/or loan agreement, and any other agreements with the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation, including amendments thereto, and including any instruments (or amendments thereto) in the effectuation thereof, in order to effect the financing or refinancing of the object or purpose described in Section 1 hereof, or a portion thereof, by a bond or note issue of said Village in the event of the sale of same to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation.

Section 8. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said Village is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 9. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

Section 10. Upon this resolution taking effect, the same shall be published in summary form in the official newspaper of said Village for such purpose, together with a notice of the Village Clerk in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 11. **THIS RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM.**
