

Village of Corfu Committee Meeting Minutes January 26, 2022

Planning and Code Enforcement:

- Received letter of resignation from Code and Zoning Enforcement Officer, Brian Schollard
- Deputy Mayor Doktor and Trustee Johnson will work on a plan for the vacated position
- 9 West Main Street sidewalk repair; homeowner put cold patch on this portion of sidewalk; Mayor Sargent will contact homeowner to follow up with the permanent fix in the Spring
