Trustee Busch said he had spoken to Jesse Stocking who said the \$5000 allotted for excavator rental in the upcoming budget could be eliminated.

Pam Ware requested to speak to the Board regarding closure on the Winterfest. She showed the Board the full page thank you ad that had been in the Akron Corfu Pennysaver and mentioned the Pennysaver had run it for half price. She also showed them a sample of a bag with various brochures they had given out at the Winterfest and said they plan to do it next year as well. She mentioned there were some of the bags left.

Deputy Mayor Bielec questioned Ms. Ware on the status of setting up a non-profit organization. She said it would take some time. He also suggested the Village could have some of the bags of brochures available in the Village Office. Ms. Ware left a box of them for the office. Ms. Ware left the meeting at 7:05 pm.

Trustee Busch continued with his Maintenance update. He said the sign boards are ready, but still needed to be taken to the school. He added that the Maintenance department did a good job on them. Trustee Lauer said he would speak to the Art teacher

at the school to set something up. Brief discussion took place regarding the layout of the signs and Trustee Busch suggested including the Village logo in the center of the bottom portion of all four signs.

Deputy Mayor Bielec updated the Board on his conversation with Attorney Boylan regarding the upcoming meeting that Trustees Ianni and Lauer will be having with the CSEA Police Union. Attorney Boylan said that all the Union representative should be doing is bringing the contract proposal and that until the Board and Attorney Boylan can review it there should be no conversation or interaction at all regarding the contract or their demands or requests.

It was questioned if the current officers and union have been notified that the Village Board is currently examining their options and may have to consider downsizing. Deputy Mayor Bielec said he had requested Trustee Ianni to contact the union regarding the possibility, so it would have to be addressed at the next meeting when Trustee Ianni is available to respond. It was agreed that the Police should be a priority at the next budget meeting.

Clerk Thomas told the Board that Al Graham of Camden Group had informed her that there would be approximately \$4000 savings on the tank cleaning from what had originally been quoted. He had said that the condition of the tanks wasn't as bad as they had anticipated.

There was a brief conversation regarding the addition of a Tim Horton's kiosk at Crosby's Corner Market. The main concern discussed was the shortage of parking spaces as it is felt that Tim Horton's will bring additional traffic to the location.

Deputy Mayor Bielec reminded the Board that he and Trustee Lauer would be meeting with Mark Masse of the GCEDC at 6:00 pm on Tuesday March 11th regarding the \$75,000 originally promised to the Village on the Sewer Project from GCEDC.

Deputy Mayor Bielec also informed the Board that he has confirmation from Graham Bowman from J. O'Connell that Mr. Bowman and Chris Grant from the Department of State would be available to meet on March 31, 2014 regarding a potential dissolution study. The meeting could determine if the Department of State would do a miniassessment at no cost to determine if a dissolution study would be beneficial to the Village and town.

Deputy Mayor Bielec requested Clerk Thomas to send Mayor Peterson notification of the Organizational meeting scheduled for April 7, 2014.

Clerk informed Board that on the budget 10% of Jesse Stocking's wages had been allotted to the Sewer department per the Board's request. The Clerk was informed that the Board had requested 10% of all Maintenance department wages be allotted to Sewer. Brief discussion took place. Clerk will rework the figures.

Trustee Lauer requested the Clerk put together a comparison of Court and Police expenditures versus revenues.

Clerks informed the Board that they would have an update on cost of replacing the office computers for the next meeting.
