- After much discussion regarding sewer plant and the best interest of the Village, Mayor Sargent and Trustee Lauer will meet with DEC and attorney to discuss options.
- Mr. Graham stated the new plant is running better each day. Mr. Eck is in constant contact with trainer from Sanitare.
- Mayor Sargent requested the gates at plant be always locked.

Beautification Update:

- Deputy Mayor Doktor met with Tyler Mutka for his Eagle Scout Project.
- All flowerpots are sold out.
- Planning Village wide garage sale for June.
- Installed more Flagpole inserts and planning on flag donation project, coming soon.

Budget:

- Discussed creek clean out – will check for waterway grants with MRB.
- Requested \$18,500 for sewer repairs from reserve fund from Freed Maxick.
- Orrick and Tom Underwood’s bills should be reallocated to grant account.

Trustee Reisdorf made a motion to move \$18,500 from sewer, repair reserve fund to sewer fund. 2nd by Trustee Lauer.
