

# Village of Corfu Regular & Year End Meeting May 27, 2020

The Village of Corfu Mayor held its Monthly Committee & Year-End Meeting at the Corfu Village Hall, 116 East Main Street on May 27, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. Present were Mayor Sargent, Deputy Mayor Graham, Trustee Lauer, Trustee Reisdorf, Trustee Doktor, Village Clerk, Jennifer Eck, and via telephone Rob McNally.

The meeting was opened at 6:30 pm followed by the Pledge to the Flag.

### Planning Update:

- Trustee Reisdorf informed the Board that he has spoken with Mark Zimmerman and there has been no interest in the Planning Board of Appeals' open vacancy
- Katie Hobbs has been progressing well with the Farmer's Market; she will be emailing vendors
- Farmer's Market opening will be July 6<sup>st</sup>; Officer Krzemien is working on establishing the traffic flow to ease frustration
- Remodel on Long's Lane home is almost complete; owner has a purchaser for the house already; recently paved the driveway and neighbor is concerned about flooding on her property, she was informed the homeowner put drains in to solve any problems
- Trustee Reisdorf will reach out to Mark Zimmerman to discuss Rezoning of the Village
- There has been no communication from Ron Long regarding Market property or Grocery Store property

#### Police Update:

- One Officer that was on restrictive duty from their permanent job has released to return; more Officers
  are still out due to restrictive duty from their permanent positions
